ANOINTING OF THE SICK AND PASTORAL CARE

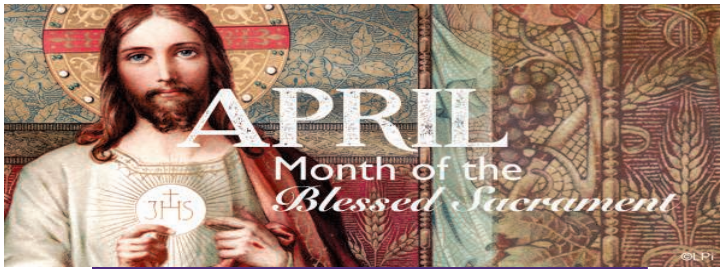

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

*You, O Lord put gladness into my heart.
 Psalm 4*

How well do we grasp the grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ, who is *True God and True Man*? This past Monday night we celebrated the transferred Solemnity of **the Annunciation of the Lord!** It is usually observed by the Church on March 25, hence the reason why we celebrate Christmas on December 25th every year! The humanity of Christ is a central dogma of our Christian faith. The Catechism challenges every person of good will with a question: *Are we willing to suffer the loss of all things ... in order to gain Christ and be found in Him ... to know Him and the power of His Resurrection & (to) share His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death (#428)?* Even the disciples in the Early Church struggled with making sense of their own suffering, persecution and hardships in spite of the glorious Resurrection of Christ our Savior. Christ speaks to every human heart when He asks the question in today's Gospel: ***Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts?*** Now is the perfect time for us to learn more about *the King of Endless Glory, the Kingdom of God and His Kingship!*

Christianity is not a spectator sport! Christ Jesus is challenging us to forsake all foolishness and *take His Gospel message from the pew to the shoe!* One of the primary purposes of the Incarnation (i.e., the Word becoming Flesh) is that: *in Christ's humanity: God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself (#433).* Some conflicted witnesses are prone to say: *Do as I say!* In the Person of Christ Jesus we find the cause for our Christian conviction, because: *His works and words will manifest Him as the Holy One of God (#438).* St. John the Apostle testifies in his Gospel: ***Now will the Son of Man be known ... when He is lifted up, they shall know, that I am.***

Above His Cross was the title: *King of the Jews*, therefore it is fitting that we discover the true meaning of His Kingship only when He is raised high on the Cross! Jesus Christ would try even to rescue Pontius Pilate from his warped world view, while testifying: ***My kingdom is not of this world!*** Despite the fact that Christianity was illegal and every disciple was in danger of death, we discover in their apostolic efforts both a willingness to share in Christ's suffering and a witness to the His coming in Glory! Like them, *may we look forward in confident hope to the Day of Resurrection!* **Glory & Praise to You: Lord Jesus Christ!** :) }
