HOME SCHOOL RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

At St. Peter Church in conformity with Diocese of Rockford, families must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Family must be registered in this parish. Registration for Religious Education begins in July: Monday through Friday in the Parish Office. Please bring a copy of the baptismal certificate if the student was not baptized in this parish
- 2) Textbooks must be approved by the United States Council of Catholic Bishops. The [Conformity Listing of Catechetical Text and Series](#) can be found on the USSCB web site.
- 3) Home School Students are to receive the sacraments along with the students from St. Peter School and Religious Education Program.
- 4) An interview with the parish priest is required to ascertain the knowledge of the sacrament as well as the prayers children should know.
